### TASTING NOTES

Super fun! Strawberry short cake in a glass.  
Wine gives off both ripe and unripe  
strawberries, tart cherries, pan dulce, sweet  
cracker, or shortbread, subtle hint of spice, &  
slight dusty road. In the mid palate the tart  
cherries and fruitiness is met with a nice  
mouth feel and texture created by the great  
acidity and tannin from the whole cluster.  
Wine finishes really juicy leaving your mouth  
watering for more. Great drinkability, perfect  
for sharing, but you'll definitely need more  
than just one bottle.
